The Bethel team is the largest group of the 54 members from congregations in the Shenandoah Presbytery who will be building houses for 3 Oaxacan Indian families, a native people of Mexico. Each build team will consist of approx. 18 people. This year the "Bethel Baja Builders" as we have named ourselves will again be taking a "Baja Suitcase" for the children. Beginning Sunday, June 6th, the "Baja Suitcase" will be located in the vestibule. We hope that you fill it to the brim and over with any "gently used" toys, stuffed animals, or sports items (soccer balls, Frisbees, small balls, kite kits, air pumps, etc.). Also appreciated are hair accessories, drawing pads, crayons, pencils and sharpeners; small purses; anything that you think that a child would enjoy having.
